Many people have asked about our light fixtures which were stolen from Boulder Hot Springs last summer so I wanted to update you on this. The sheriff's department has been very cooperative, however, nothing has come out of their investigation. We still do not have the light fixtures back. Our insurance company has covered some of the cost of the stolen fixtures, and we have purchased some of the light covers (globes that go over the bulbs) on-line. We also have purchased a Mission light fixture of a different style to hang in the lobby above our card-playing figures. We are still hoping to get the fixtures back that were stolen. If you have any leads, please let us know.

In addition, I want to let you know that this year is a centennial anniversary of the East Wing of our building and also of the building as it is today. In 1909 a Butte millionaire miner and banker named, James Murray, bought Boulder Hot Springs, and in 1910 there was a major enlargement and renovation of the building. Murray had spent a lot of time in California and loved the architecture there so he added fountains and arches to the Hot Springs and had it stuccoed making it into the California Mission style building it is today.

In celebration of this centennial, we are offering a coupon (see page 3) for 10% off of a pool use visit or a room. In addition, this summer we plan to have some special events to commemorate this exciting and joyous event. We hope you can join us in celebrating Boulder Hot Springs' birthday.

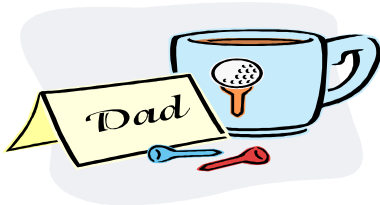

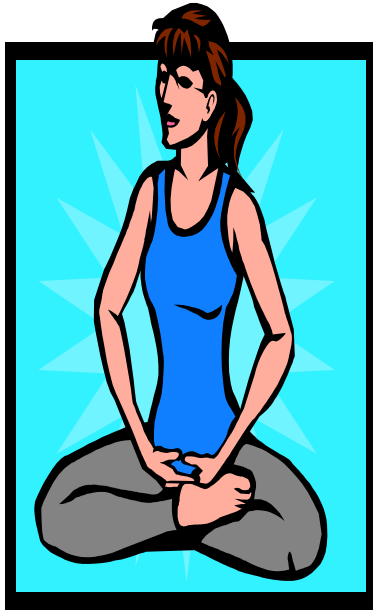
