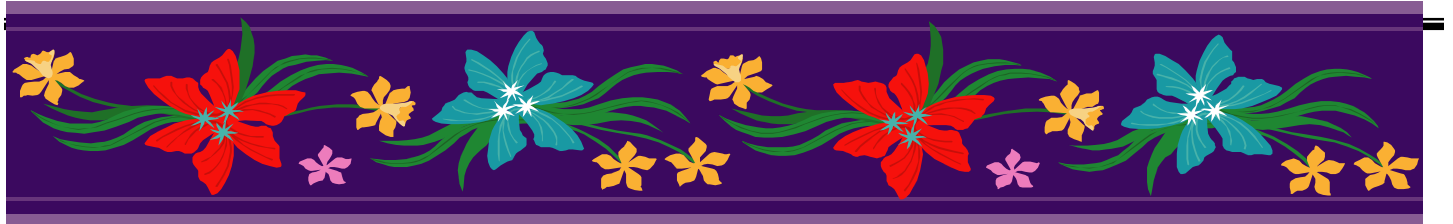

What's Happening at Boulder Hot Springs

One of the ways we know that spring has finally settled in at Boulder Hot Springs is that the birds announce its arrival. They are the messengers who let us know that winter has at last lost its tight grip on this peaceful valley.

First we begin to hear the red-winged blackbirds. Then, the sandhill cranes appear. This year, we were also blessed to have three regal, graceful trumpeter swans on our pond for a few days.

In addition, we get plenty of Canadian Geese. Some stop, nest, and hatch their eggs here. Last year, there were three families of geese residing by and on the pond. One family had five adorable goslings, one family had six and the third family had seven. It was fun to watch the babies swimming behind their parents in a single file. This year we have a similar scenario.

Last year, a birder came to Boulder Hot Springs and reported seeing or hearing over 30 species of birds in the area. His list included great blue herons, mountain bluebirds, nine different kinds of swallows, killdeers, red-tailed hawks, Wilson's Snipes, and European Starlings to name a few.

Recently we had a visitor, Brian Curtis, who was from Oregon. He is the grandson of Mr. and Mrs. Albert Lane who purchased the Hot Springs from Pappy Smith in 1960. He shared that he visited the Diamond S (as Boulder Hot Springs was called at the time) in the early '60's. He remembers that as a child, he stood looking out the window and seeing a magpie on the fence. It was the first magpie he had ever seen.

We are so lucky that the birds have chosen Boulder Hot Springs as one of their annual stopping places. We invite you to join us and enjoy the bird watching and bird sounds that surround us here.

On another front, we want to let you know that we continue to work on the restoration of the west wing. Currently, the ceiling of the old barroom is being insulated and sound-proofed and we are preparing to install new exterior doors. The other work that has been done recently on the barroom is that we have installed the piping for the in-floor heating. In the process of dealing with some structural issues, we were able to make the old barroom feel more open and spacious.

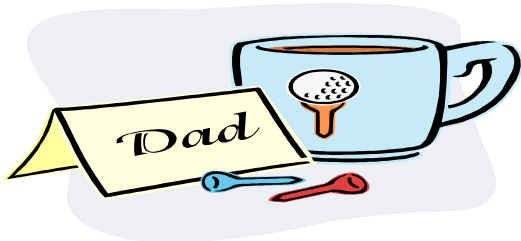
We are hoping soon to have it available for public use.

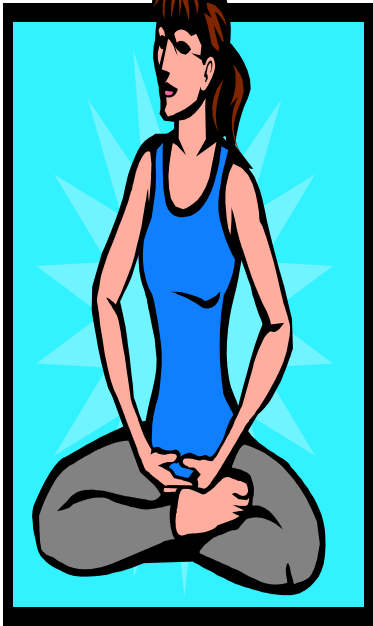
